Zionsville Community High School (ZCSH) Student Transition and Employment Partnership (STEP) program helps special needs students learn skills needed to gain independence, transition to work, obtain functional life skills, and strengthen character.

Teacher Julie Noel was awarded a 2017 Fall Classroom Grant, *Trailblazers - STEPS to Independence*.
