# Making Sense of Math in the Real World

Liz Ferrand, Zionsville West Middle School (\$1,150)

Making connections between what is being learned in a math classroom and what it is important is key for student engagement and success. This grant will allow students to make the real world connection between school and life, as well as, promote service learning within our community.

## **Outdoor Musical Garden**

Molly Haas, Eagle Elementary (\$8,684.55)

The Eagle Musical Garden experience will provide students with access to outdoor musical instruments in an effort to enhance their musical abilities, promote positive mindfulness practices, and support hand-on science curriculum.
