


Hands-on experiences are invaluable to all learners and it is no different for Liz McNamara's students. ZMS teacher Liz McNamara was awarded a ZEF 2018 Fall Classroom Grant, ZMS Essential Skills Classes to Attend Morning Dove Therapeutic Riding, Zionsville.

Mrs. McNamara created a curriculum unit including a series of visits to the Morning Dove Therapeutic Riding Center. In-class preparation started in the fall giving students context for the visits to come and information about horses - their body parts, what they eat, caring for a horse - that they can then apply and experience through four sessions at Morning Dove.

The first visit to Morning Dove took place on Monday, April 8 and was a resounding success. Students were introduced to the horses, learned about their personalities, helped care for the horses, and ate lunch at the site. We can't wait to see how this ZEF Classroom Grant grows in the weeks ahead!
