ZEF Grants in Action:

Exploring the Stories of Readers, Writers, and Historians



Zionsville Middle School (ZMS) Media Specialist Kelsey Buckley and Humanities Teacher Emily Wleklinski were awarded a 2018 Spring Classroom Grant, *Exploring the Stories of Readers, Writers, and Historians*. This grant provided 1,200+ ZMS students the opportunity to hear from *The New York Times* bestselling author Alan Gratz.

Mr. Gratz talked with students in a *Choose Your Own Adventure* style presentation, answered questions, signed copies of his book, and visited with an after-school book club.

ZMS students read books by Alan Gratz in preparation for his visit and in conjunction with current curriculum. Major historical events are told from the perspective of an adolescent in many of his works. These books spark great discussions about human connection and varying perspectives in some of history's major events. Students learned about his writing process and the vast amount of research that goes into each of his historical fiction novels.
