Her husband, Rick Graef, and their family partnered with ZEF to create the Sandy Graef Memorial Fund to honor her life and her passion for music education. The fund supports the Zionsville Middle School and Zionsville West Middle School band programs with an annual grant.

"Sandy Graef was an amazing educator, friend, and the world's biggest fan of

music in Zionsville Community Schools," said ZMS Music Department Chair Josh Weirich. "Her energy and passion inspired her students and co-workers. She also brought a high level of musicality and organization that created a foundation for the high achieving middle school band programs we see today with large student participation and accolades locally and nationally. The memorial fund enables us to continue her legacy of helping students and providing quality music instruction in Zionsville."

The memorial provides funds for middle school band student needs not otherwise available in tight school budgets. "Sandy was always looking for ways to help her students," said Rick. "She had a passion for ensuring that all students had access to quality instruction, music experiences, and the tools they needed to be successful."


