ZEF Grants In Action: ZCHS S.O.A.R.S.



ZCHS teachers Spencer Cassin and Amanda Lucas recently talked with our Board of Directors about two impactful ZEF grants. They work with the Zionsville Community High School (ZCHS) Student Opportunities to Achieve Real-life Success (S.O.A.R.S.) and Functional Academics classes at ZCHS and consistently find creative ways for students to experience real-life situations that promote independence, leadership, job skills, and social development.

In 2018, Mr. Cassin and Natalie Sarcona were awarded a grant entitled *Grow Well Initiative - School Tower Gardens*. The initial grant provided tower gardens to grow edible plans sustainably year-round in the classroom. The towers were successfully

used that way for several years. Today, the impact of those gardens has expanded to help provide jobs for students as caretakers for these gardens and others in our community. They provide interaction with mainstream classrooms and help students work towards independence after high school.

Mr. Cassin and Ms. Lucas received a 2021 Spring Classroom Grant for *Finishing Carts*. This project gives students that finish class work before their peers access to independent work tasks that help with fine motor, academic, and vocational skills.

These two grants demonstrate the lasting impact of ZEF grants and the exponential positive impact creative teachers have on student learning every day at ZCS.
