With the use of Infento Kits, students have the opportunity to fully immerse themselves in the engineering design process. This ZEF grant gives students the ability to explore how engineering impacts their lives by creating their own life-sized transportation and inspire more students to pursue STEM careers. Students work in groups to build a mode of transportation that would have a minimal impact on the environment and reduce emissions.

Every 5th grade class at ZMS had the



opportunity to use the kits during the past school year. The kits are completely modular and reusable enabling them to be used for multiple designs for years to come.
